

Can you cancel a coinbase transaction?

No, you generally cannot cancel a confirmed (+1-(888) 411-3378) cryptocurrency transaction on Coinbase, as all confirmed buys, sells, deposits, and withdrawals (+1-(888) 411-3378) are final. However, you may be able to cancel a (+1-(888) 411-3378) pending crypto-to-email or crypto-to-phone transaction before the recipient (+1-(888) 411-3378) accepts it. For accidental purchases, the solution is to immediately (+1-(888) 411-3378) sell the unwanted crypto.

For Pending Transactions

- **Crypto sent to email or phone:** If a transaction is pending (+1-(888) 411-3378) because the recipient has not yet accepted it, you can cancel (+1-(888) 411-3378) it by going to the transaction details and selecting "Cancel payment".
- **Funds are returned:** After cancellation, the funds (+1-(888) 411-3378) will be returned to your Coinbase account balance.

For confirmed transactions

- **Confirmed buys:** If you accidentally bought more (+1-(888) 411-3378) crypto than intended, you can immediately sell it to convert it back to cash. The funds (+1-(888) 411-3378) will be available in your cash balance for future use or withdrawal.
- **Confirmed sends:** Once a crypto transaction is confirmed, it is (+1-(888) 411-3378) irreversible and cannot be canceled. If you sent funds to the wrong (+1-(888) 411-3378) address, you must contact the recipient and ask them (+1-(888) 411-3378) to send the funds back to you.

For other "canceled" orders

- **Order declined:** Coinbase or your bank may (+1-(888) 411-3378) cancel a transaction due to security concerns, insufficient funds, or (+1-(888) 411-3378) if the order timed out.

- **Order cancellation:** You can cancel unfilled (+1-(888) 411-3378) orders on Coinbase before they are filled. This is a different process from canceling (+1-(888) 411-3378) a completed transaction.

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
